

Reichert Celebration 2010

All Breed Youth Team Tournament

FAQ's

Q: Are teams drawn by horse or rider?

A: Teams are drawn by rider. Sponsors will draw the Team Captain of each team. The team captains will then draw their first team member and continue down until all youth are placed on a team.

Q: How many classes can I enter?

A: You may show a maximum of 5 classes.

Q: Can I use more than one horse?

A: Yes, you may use up to five horses. Therefore you may use one horse for each class, or one horse for two classes and another for three.

Q: When is the entry deadline?

A: All entries must be postmarked by July 12th, and include a copy of your horse/horse's registration papers and a copy of your breed youth membership card.

Q: Can more than one team member show in one class?

(Ex. Team member 1 and 2 both showing in Trail)

A: Yes, team members may show with fellow teammates in the same class.

Q: Do I have to show in other classes in the Reichert Celebration to show in the Team Tournament?

A: No, you do not have to show in The Reichert Celebration to be able to participate in the Team Tournament.

Q: Do I have to reserve a stall to be eligible to show in the Team Tournament?

A: Yes, you must reserve a stall for each horse you will be showing in the Team Tournament. Please see the Stall Reservation Form for more information.

Q: How much does a stall for the Team Tournament cost?

A: Paid by July 16 is \$134 (Stall \$100+4 bags of shavings \$34= \$134, and after July 16 is \$159.

Q: How much is bedding?

A: Shavings are pre-bedded with 4 bags and cost \$8.50 per bag. Additional shavings must be purchased from the horse show facility.

Q: Do I need a trailer parking pass if I am *only* showing one day for the Team Tournament?

A: Yes, all trailers which will be parked on the horse show grounds must purchase a Trailer Parking Pass at \$20.00.

Q: Do I get to put my team together?

A: No, there will be a random draw. We wanted to prevent 'stacking of the teams.'

Q: Where do we pick up our numbers?

A: At the show office in the Ford Livestock arena. Check in time is Sunday from 1-7 p.m.

Q: Do I have to attend the Youth Reception on Saturday night?

A: No, however that is where we will be passing out the jeans and shirts. There will also be a party for the youth to get to know each other.

Q: What if I can't make it to the office during those times?

A: Please notify the show office at (918) 744-1113 and we will have your packet available at 7 a.m. in the Pavilion office.

Q: What if I don't show in all the classes I signed up for?

A: We hope that you do, however you will only hurt your team and chance to win if you do.

Q: If our team wins or gets second, when will I receive the scholarship money?

A: You will receive your scholarship money second semester. Please send a transcript and proof of enrollment.

Q: What if I have a conflict with the NSBA, APHA, or ApHC Shows?

A: We will make every reasonable attempt to accommodate your requests. Please let the staff know of the possible conflict as soon as possible. The classes in the Ford arena will take precedence over the classes in Super Duty and Mustang arenas.
